MODALITY:

PARTICIPANTS:

- One Category
- Minimum five students per delegation.

OBJETIVES:

- Promote participation and integration among students from the different SEK schools.
- Promote the awareness of Ecuadorian poetry, encourage creativity, and practice of contemporary dance.
- Motivate body expression through dance, thus contributing to the overall development of students.

REGULATIONS:

- The choreographic composition should be done based on the given theme, reflecting that message through dance.
- The choreography must be original.
- The choreography must last 3 to 5 minutes.
- Delegation must be represented by a minimum of 5 students.
- One choreography per school will be presented.
- The setting and display of props is under the responsibility of each country in competition, while the sound equipment will be provided by the host school.
- Each country must submit an original and a copy of the music to be used on a CD, labeled with name of the country and choreography.





EVALUATION SYSTEM

- The jury will consist of professional dancers invited from the 'Casa de la Cultura Ecuatoriana.'
- For the evaluation of the choreographies the following aspects will be taken into account:
 - o Choreography and message.
 - o Stage projection.
 - o Interpretation.
 - o Music.
 - o Outfit.
